A 24-year-rugby player presented at our shoulder and elbow clinic complaining of multiple episodes of traumatic anterior shoulder dislocation that severely restricted his athletic performance. An arthro-MRI showed a severe bony Bankart lesion, and the patient was scheduled for an arthroscopic Latarjet procedure. The bony Bankart lesion was confirmed at surgery, and a coracoid graft fixed with two screws reconstructed it.
